





ALPI products have always been made in the city of Modigliana, in the province of Forlì-Cesena, in a social and environmental context traditionally favourable to the sustainable manufacturing of reconstituted wood. ALPI products bring aesthetically designed excellence to the entire world, along with corporate values rooted in local culture and respect for the environment.

Starting with the forests and cultivations it manages, mainly in Cameroon, ALPI is committed to preserving the environment from all forms of deterioration. It identifies risks in its production processes and mitigates the real and potential impact of these while considering the consequences of transporting raw material and finished product, and employees' travel between work and home.
